TOP THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

ATHOC AND PEAK ALERTS SET-UP FOR DEPENDENTS

In an effort to better communicate various weather and installation emergency conditions, the AtHoc system allows the service member/sponsor to register their dependent's contact information to receive text message and phone call notifications. See the graphic posted to the bulletin on how to register your dependents for notifications.

Additionally, local Colorado Springs public safety agencies (police, sheriff, fire and emergency services) use a system called Peak Alerts to directly notify members of the community of dangerous conditions and actions that people should take during an emergency.

Peak Alerts notifications are targeted geographically, so agencies can narrow the notification to just those who are affected by the emergency situation. You can sign up for Peak Alerts at peakalerts.org.
