

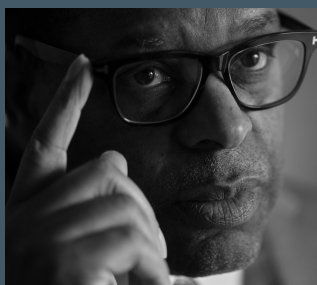

TOP THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

FRONT RANGE BONE MARROW DRIVE

The Front Range will be participating in a Bone Marrow Drive from Jan. 30 to Feb. 10, 2023. Registration is open to all DoD cardholders and is quick and easy; it only requires a consent form and cheek swab! When a member joins the registry through the Salute to Life program, they are added to the national bone marrow registry, where they may become a match for any individual within the United States that is in need of a life-saving bone marrow transplant. Members can join the registry at booths held all across both bases during the drive, to include the medical group annex, BX/commissary, DISH Dining Hall (Schriever), and Fitness Center (Schriever).
