TOP THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

STORM DAMAGE CLAIMS PROCESS FOR PERSONAL PROPERTY

All personal claims due to the 8 July 2023 storm must be filed online with the Air Force Claims Service Center (AFCSC). Claims can only be filed regarding damage to personal property (e.g., vehicle or household goods) that was located on SBD 1 installations in Colorado Springs, CO, and damaged due to the storm.

First, you will need to file your claim for damage with your insurance carrier for initial handling. You will then need to file a claim with AFCSC for potential reimbursement of anything your insurance carrier did not cover, or potentially your insurance deductible. You must provide all documents related to the incident to the AFCSC. This will include either proof the claim was paid or denied by your insurance carrier. AFCSC will be the one to determine if your claim is non-payable or payable.

Visit <https://claims.jag.af.mil> and scroll down to the "Important!!" section and click on the "File Non Household Goods Claim" and follow the directions from there. Use the following username and password in order to file a claim as they are specific to the 8 July storm—**User Name:** clai3897; **Password:** KtD!Qx2W

Although the SBD 1 legal office cannot file the claim for you, you may contact the office at 719- 556-4871 or 719-567-5050 should you have questions.

Proper Claimants include:

- Active Duty AF military personnel
- AF Reserve or ANG personnel if performing federally funded duty, inactive duty for training or full-time ANG duty
- ANG technicians under 32 U.S.C. 709
- Civilian employees whom the AF pays from appropriated or nonappropriated funds for claims resulting from incident to service losses (Note that incident to service is normally considered only loss or damage related to the actual performance of their duty. This usually limits losses that occur at the office or place of duty and for vehicles parked at your place of duty.)
- Civilian employees of DeCA who work on an AF installation
- AFROTC cadets or USAFA cadets
