SUBJECT: Delay of Fitness Assessments for Peterson-Schriever Garrison Personnel

- 1. Given the current state of the COVID-19 pandemic and the need to ensure the readiness of our force, we will pause official Physical Fitness Assessments (PFAs) for Peterson-Schriever Garrison effective immediately with plans to resume testing on 1 March 2022.
- 2. All personnel projected to test during this timeframe will have assessment dates adjusted in the Air Force Fitness Management System (AFFMS II). Members will reflect "due" for testing on 1 March 2022 and will be required to test NLT 31 March 2022. There will not be a 42-day exemption upon resuming testing as there is for a PCS.
- 3. Commanders should not direct testing for any personnel during this delay. However, members who are due to test during this period may voluntarily coordinate a one-on-one diagnostic test or official PFA with their Squadron Physical Training Leader (PTL) to allow testing if they choose.
- 4. Maintaining a fit warfighting force is imperative to our lethality and readiness posture. As such, all Airmen and Guardians should actively participate in a regimen that ensures compliance with Air Force fitness standards throughout this temporary delay in testing. During this pause, we will continue to coordinate with Public Health officials and update local policies and procedures in accordance with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the DoD, and local guidelines. The safety and well-being of our members is a top priority, and we will continue to take appropriate measures to mitigate COVID-19 exposures.
